JNL has not completed any harvesting in Totara since 2019.

Access has been given to Forest Enterprises LTD to haul logs from their neighbouring forest through Ross Road and out to the Waiomoko Road. An agreement has been developed and signed by both parties. This activity has not interfered with the Totara HCV forest



Pest Control

Below is a list of pest culling activities that occurred in 2023:

- Feral pest solutions culling 70 goats
- Enviropest (contractor) culling April 2025 25 goats, 2 deer
- Bait stations filled with Double tap baits
- 15 deer taken by JNL staff and permit holders.

JNL issued hunting permits to the public for the first annual Waimata Catchment Cull competition and the second annual Whangara Catchment Cull competition. Totara forest overlaps both catchments.

Monitoring

A new management and monitoring plan has been developed for the Totara HCV by an external consultant. This plan is currently out for stakeholder consultation. Once feedback has been received the plan will be implemented.
